16 Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil; 17 Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow. 18 Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.

Introduction

A. How strange that God invites people to come to Him Luke 19:10

For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

B. Isaiah called us to invite people to come and be clean Ephesians 5:26

That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

C. What's this invitation all about?

I. An Invitation To Reason At An Unreasonable Time

"Come now and let us reason together"

- A. A nation in deep trouble
- B. The people had rebelled against the Lord Isaiah 1:2-4
- 2 Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth: for the LORD hath spoken, I have nourished and brought up children, and they have rebelled against me.
- 3 The ox knoweth his owner, and the ass his master's crib: but Israel doth not know, my people doth not consider.
- 4 Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward.

I. An Invitation To Reason At An Unreasonable Time

C. They had not responded to chastening

Isaiah 1:5

Why should ye be stricken any more? ye will revolt more and more: the whole head is sick, and the whole heart faint.

D. God's invitation was still there

Romans 10:21

But to Israel he saith, All day long I have stretched forth my hands unto a disobedient and gainsaying people.

II. An Invitation From God At An Ungodly Time

"saith the Lord"

- A. God called to those who had forsaken Him (1:4)
- B. These people reminded Isaiah of Sodom and Gomorrah

Isaiah 1:9-10

- 9 Except the LORD of hosts had left unto us a very small remnant, we should have been as Sodom, and we should have been like unto Gomorrah.
- 10 Hear the word of the LORD, ye rulers of Sodom; give ear unto the law of our God, ye people of Gomorrah.

II. An Invitation From God At An Ungodly Time

- C. Even their feasts were an abomination to the Lord Isaiah 1:11-14
- 11 To what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices unto me? saith the LORD: I am full of the burnt offerings of rams, and the fat of fed beasts; and I delight not in the blood of bullocks, or of lambs, or of he goats.
- 12 When ye come to appear before me, who hath required this at your hand, to tread my courts?

II. An Invitation From God At An Ungodly Time

- C. Even their feasts were an abomination to the Lord Isaiah 1:11-14 continued
- 13 Bring no more vain oblations; incense is an abomination unto me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; it is iniquity, even the solemn meeting.
- 14 Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear them.
- D. God keeps inviting them to come and be clean

III. An Invitation For Cleansing At A Sinful Time

- A. This is an invitation to be forgiven
- 2 Chronicles 7:14
- If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- B. This was the desire of David's heart after his sin Psalm 51:7
- Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

III. An Invitation For Cleansing At A Sinful Time

God meets sinners where they are and cleanses them

John 8:11

She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

God is still calling today !!!
