Matthew 11:25-30

- 25 At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.
- 26 Even so, Father: for so it seemed good in thy sight. 27 All things are delivered unto me of my Father: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and he to whomsoever the Son will reveal him.

- 28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

C. Do you need to find strength to go on?

Isaiah 40:31

But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Philippians 4:13

I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

I. An Invitation To Physical Rest (v 28)

Those who come to Jesus find rest

- A. The invitation is to all who "are heavy laden"
- B. Emotional burdens drain our strength Psalm 127:2
- It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: for so he giveth his beloved sleep.

- C. The heavy laden with cares can find rest in Christ
 - 1. We cast our cares on Him
- 1 Peter 5:7

Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.

2. He gives peace when we are troubled John 14:27

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

- C. The heavy laden with cares can find rest in Christ cont'd
 - 3. His peace guards our hearts
- Philippians 4:7
- And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

- C. The heavy laden with cares can find rest in Christ cont'd
 - 4. His grace is sufficient for all our needs
- 2 Corinthians 12:9

And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

- A. The promise is "ye shall find rest to your souls"
- B. Our souls never rest until they rest in Him Isaiah 14:3
- And it shall come to pass in the day that the LORD shall give thee rest from thy sorrow, and from thy fear, and from the hard bondage wherein thou wast made to serve,

C. Mankind struggles for rest of soul

Ecclesiastes 6:10-11

10 That which hath been is named already, and it is known that it is man: neither may he contend with him that is mightier than he.

11 Seeing there be many things that increase vanity, what is man the better?

D. Only Christ brings rest of soul Titus 3:5

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
