# **I. The Constant Heart (119:161-163)**

## **A. Directed by the Word (119:161)**

### **1. When fearful in trials (v 161a)**

**Psalm 146:3**

**Put not your trust in princes, nor in the son of man, in whom there is no help.**

**John 15:25**

**But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause.**

# **I. The Constant Heart (119:161-163)**

## **A. Directed by the Word (119:161) - continued**

### **2. When fearing God (v 161b)**

**Proverbs 28:14**

**Happy *is* the man that feareth alway: but he that hardeneth his heart shall fall into mischief.**

# **I. The Constant Heart (119:161-163)**

## **B. Delighted by the Word (119:162)**

### **1. Causes exultation (v 162a)**

**Psalm 119:14**

**I have rejoiced in the way of thy testimonies, as *much*  
*as* in all riches.**

# **I. The Constant Heart (119:161-163)**

## **B. Delighted by the Word (119:162) - continued**

### **2. Causes exuberation (v 163b)**

#### **2 Kings 7:9**

**Then they said one to another, We do not well: this day is a day of good tidings, and we hold our peace: if we tarry till the morning light, some mischief will come upon us: now therefore come, that we may go and tell the king's household.**

# **I. The Constant Heart (119:161-163)**

## **C. Dedicated to the Word (119:163)**

### **1. Denounces lies (v 163a)**

**Romans 12:9**

**Let love be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good.**

# **I. The Constant Heart (119:161-163)**

## **C. Dedicated to the Word (119:163)**

### **2. Devoted to truth (v 163b)**

**John 14:21**

**He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.**

**Joshua 23:11**

**Take good heed therefore unto yourselves, that ye love the LORD your God.**

## **II. The Constant Life (119:164-166)**

### **A. In praise (119:164)**

#### **1. The opportunity (v 164a)**

**Psalm 44:8**

**In God we boast all the day long, and praise thy name for ever. Selah.**



## **II. The Constant Life (119:164-166)**

### **A. In praise (119:164) - continued**

#### **2. The object (v 164b)**

#### **Philippians 4:8**

**Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.**

### **B. In peace (119:165)**

#### **1. With God (v 165a)**

**Romans 5:1**

**Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:**

## **II. The Constant Life (119:164-166)**

### **B. In peace (119:165) - continued**

#### **2. From God (v 165b)**

##### **Romans 15:13**

**Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost.**

##### **Philippians 4:7**

**And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.**

## **II. The Constant Life (119:164-166)**

### **B. In peace (119:165) - continued**

#### **2. From God (v 165b)**

**Mark 4:17**

**And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.**

## **II. The Constant Life (119:164-166)**

### **C. In practice (119:166)**

#### **1. With faith (v 166a)**

**Hebrews 11:1**

**Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.**

#### **2. With follow-through (v 166b)**

**James 1:22, 25**

**But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.**

### **III. The Constant Keeper Of Commandments (119:167-168)**

#### **A. Out of love for God and His Word (119:167)**

**John 14:15**

**If ye love me, keep my commandments.**

**John 15:10**

**If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.**

**1 John 5:3**

**For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.**

# **III. The Constant Keeper Of Commandments (119:167-168)**

## **B. Out of a life of obedience (119:168)**

### **1. Trusting God (v 168a)**

**Psalm 119:128**

**Therefore I esteem all *thy* precepts *concerning* all *things* to be right; and I hate every false way.**

### **2. Transparent to God (v 168b)**

**Romans 12:1**

**I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.**
