John 1:35-42

- 35 Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples;
- 36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God!
- 37 And the two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus.
- 38 Then Jesus turned, and saw them following, and saith unto them, What seek ye? They said unto him, Rabbi, (which is to say, being interpreted, Master,) where dwellest thou?

John 1:35-42 - continued

- 39 He saith unto them, Come and see. They came and saw where he dwelt, and abode with him that day: for it was about the tenth hour.
- 40 One of the two which heard John speak, and followed him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.
- 41 He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messias, which is, being interpreted, the Christ.
- 42 And he brought him to Jesus. And when Jesus beheld him, he said, Thou art Simon the son of Jona: thou shalt be called Cephas, which is by interpretation, A stone.

A. John the Baptist's statement has pointed the way Hebrews 11:6

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

C. Come and see Jesus and trust Him to save you Psalm 34:8

O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him.

II. Come And See, And You'll Want To Stay (v 39)

- A. "They came ... and abode with him that day"
- B. The presence of God should want us to stay Exodus 33:11
- And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend. And he turned again into the camp: but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.

II. Come And See, And You'll Want To Stay (v 39)

C. The glory of God should want us to stay Matthew 17:4

Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.

II. Come And See, And You'll Want To Stay (v 39)

- D. The worth of God should want us to stay Philippians 3:7-8
- 7 But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for Christ.
- 8 Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ,

III. Come And See, And You'll Show Others The Way (vv 40-42)

- A. Andrew could not keep this good news to himself Matthew 10:32
- Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven.
- B. Andrew first found and told his brother, Simon Peter 1 Corinthians 9:16
- For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!
