







John 6:35-41

35 And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.
36 But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not.
37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.

John 6:35-41 - continued

- 38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.
- **39** And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.
- 40 And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.
- 41 The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, I am the bread which came down from heaven.

Introduction

- A. We all seek safety
- Psalm 4:8
- I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for thou, LORD, only makest me dwell in safety.
- **B.** A promise that we can depend on (v 37)
- **C.** This promise stems from an invitation

A. "Him that cometh to me"

B. Receiving Christ is placing faith in Him
1. We become aware of our sinful condition
1 John 1:10
If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar,

and his word is not in us.

2. We understand we cannot save ourselves Titus 3:5

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

B. Receiving Christ is placing faith in Him - continued

3. We stop trying to earn favor with God Matthew 7:22

Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

4. We trust in the Lord Jesus Christ as personal Savior

John 1:12

But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

- A. "I will in no wise cast out"
- **B.** Those who come find Christ's arms open wide to receive them

The Savior Is Waiting, Verse 2

If you'll take one step Toward the Savior, my friend, You'll find His arms open wide. Receive Him, and all of your darkness will end Within your heart He'll abide.

C. Here is a two-way meeting:

1. A seeking sinner meets a seeking Savior

Psalm 53:2

God looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, that did seek God.

Luke 19:10

For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

2. A receiving sinner meets a receiving Savior

D. The moment we meet we become the children of God1. We become heirs of God, joint heirs with ChristRomans 8:17

And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.

- **D.** The moment we meet we become the children of God (continued)
 - 2. We will never be separated from His love
- **Romans 8:38-39**
- 38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,
- **39** Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

III. To Come To Jesus Is To Receive Eternal Life From Him

- A. The promise from God (v 37) 1 John 5:11
- And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.

John 10:28

And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

III. To Come To Jesus Is To Receive Eternal Life From Him

- **B.** The promise is sealed (6:38-40)
 - 1. Christ came to do the Father's will (v 38)
 - 2. The Father wills that not one believer be lost (v 39)
 - 3. The Father wills that all believers be resurrected (v 39)
- **1 Corinthians 15:51-52**
- 51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
- 52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

III. To Come To Jesus Is To Receive Eternal Life From Him

4. The Father wills that all believers have everlasting life (v 40)
1 John 2:25
And this is the promise that he hath promised us, even eternal life.
