



John 13:36-38

36 Simon Peter said unto him, Lord, whither goest thou? Jesus answered him, Whither I go, thou canst not follow me now; but thou shalt follow me afterwards.
37 Peter said unto him, Lord, why cannot I follow thee now? I will lay down my life for thy sake.
38 Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice.

- 1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.
- 2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- 4 And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.
- **5** Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

John 14:1-9 - continued

- 6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- 7 If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.
- 8 Philip saith unto him, Lord, show us the Father, and it sufficith us.
- 9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father?

Introduction

A. Jesus has prepared His disciples for His coming death Mark 10:32-34

32 And they were in the way going up to Jerusalem; and Jesus went before them: and they were amazed; and as they followed, they were afraid. And he took again the twelve, and began to tell them what things should happen unto him, 33 Saying, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be delivered unto the chief priests, and unto the scribes; and they shall condemn him to death, and shall deliver him to the Gentiles:

34 And they shall mock him, and shall scourge him, and shall spit upon him, and shall kill him: and the third day he shall rise again.

B. The disciples have some personal questions and desires

- 1. Peter wants to follow Jesus ... now
- 2. Thomas wants to know the way to heaven
- **3. Philip wants to see the Father**

I. The Desire Of Peter To Follow Jesus (13:37)

- A. "Why cannot I follow thee now?"
- **B.** Jesus had already told Peter he could not follow Him then (v 36)
- **C.** Peter was trying to force God's plan into his timetable Matthew 16:22-23
- 22 Then Peter took him, and began to rebuke him, saying,Be it far from thee, Lord: this shall not be unto thee.23 But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me,Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest notthe things that be of God, but those that be of men.

I. The Desire Of Peter To Follow Jesus (13:37)

D. Many have tried to do the will of God on their terms1. This is sure to bring failure

- 2. God's way and time are always best
- **Isaiah 55:8-9**
- 8 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD.
- 9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

B. Thomas has just heard the most loved text on heaven

C. Thomas wanted to make sure he would be included

D. He lacked assurance of heaven

II. The Desire Of Thomas To Know The way To Heaven (14:5)

E. Jesus settles it for Thomas (v 6)
1. The way: that the will of man may choose it
Matthew 7:14
Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which
leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.

2. The truth: that the mind of man may comprehend it Philippians 4:7

And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

II. The Desire Of Thomas To Know The way To Heaven (14:5)

E. Jesus settles it for Thomas (v 6) - continued
3. The life: that the heart of man may experience it
John 10:10
The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to
destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that
they might have it more abundantly.

III. The Desire Of Philip To See The Father (14:8)

A. "Lord, show us the Father and it sufficient us"
1. Let us see the Father and we'll be satisfied
Hebrews 4:1
Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left us of
entering into his rest, any of you should seem to
come short of it.

2. Reveals that Philip hadn't been listening

B. Jesus' reply - "He that hath seen me hath seen the Father"

C. The mystery of the Trinity
