A. Need to know where Jesus is (6:1)

John 6:1

After these things Jesus went over the sea of Galilee, which is the sea of Tiberias.

Isaiah 55:6

Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:

B. Need to know what Jesus can do (6:2)

John 6:2

And a great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased.

Isaiah 61:1

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

- C. Need to go where Jesus goes (6:3-4)
- John 6:3-4
- 3 And Jesus went up into a mountain, and there he sat with his disciples.
- 4 And the passover, a feast of the Jews, was nigh.

C. Need to go where Jesus goes (6:3-4)

Mark 6:33-34

- 33 And the people saw them departing, and many knew him, and ran afoot thither out of all cities, and outwent them, and came together unto him.
- 34 And Jesus, when he came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and he began to teach them many things.

- 5 When Jesus then lifted up his eyes, and saw a great company come unto him, he saith unto Philip, Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat?

B. Assets are insufficient without faith (6:7)

John 6:7

Philip answered him, Two hundred pennyworth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may take a little.

- 8 One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him,
- 9 There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many?

D. Action is necessary to see faith work (6:10)

John 6:10

And Jesus said, Make the men sit down. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand. (Mark 6:39-40)

Hebrews 4:2

For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.

E. Allowing Christ to work with what you have is essential (6:11)

John 6:11

And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.

- F. Abundance is available through faith (6:12-13) John 6:12-13
- 12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost.
- 13 Therefore they gathered them together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten.

- G. Acknowledgment should result from faith (6:14-15)
 - 1. Not what you think (v 14)

John 6:14

Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

2. Not what you want (v 15)

John 6:15

When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take him by force, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone.

John 6:16-17

16 And when even was now come, his disciples went down unto the sea,

17 And entered into a ship, and went over the sea toward Capernaum. And it was now dark, and Jesus was not come to them.

B. When languishing in effort (6:18-19)

John 6:18-19

18 And the sea arose by reason of a great wind that blew. 19 So when they had rowed about five and twenty or thirty furlongs, they see Jesus walking on the sea, and drawing nigh unto the ship: and they were afraid.

Mark 6:48

And he saw them toiling in rowing; for the wind was contrary unto them: and about the fourth watch of the night he cometh unto them, walking upon the sea, and would have passed by them.

C. When limited by fear (6:20)

John 6:20

But he saith unto them, It is I; be not afraid.

D. Faith will get you where God wants you to be (6:21) John 6:21

Then they willingly received him into the ship: and immediately the ship was at the land whither they went.
