Psalm 23

- 1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.
- 2 He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.
- 3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.
- 4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

- 5 Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.
- 6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.

C. Christ is the shepherd that is coming back who will bring His reward

1 Peter 5:4

And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

I. Satisfaction (23:1)

A. Sheep do not worry about tomorrow because they follow the shepherd

Matthew 6:26

Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?

I. Satisfaction (23:1)

B. Neither should we want or worry about the future Matthew 6:31

Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

Matthew 6:33-34a

33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. 34 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself...

Philippians 4:19

But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

II. Serenity (23:2)

A. The shepherd gives his sheep rest

Matthew 11:28

Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

II. Serenity (23:2)

B. Sheep are fearful of violent water Isaiah 25:4

For thou hast been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shadow from the heat, when the blast of the terrible ones is as a storm against the wall.

Psalm 107:29

He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still.

II. Serenity (23:2)

C. We must be drawn to rest, meditate, and pray Psalm 46:10a

Be still, and know that I am God:

John 14:27

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

III. Strength (23:3)

A. Sheep are weak, have poor sight, and a poor sense of direction

Isaiah 53:6

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

III. Strength (23:3)

B. The Lord restores our strength when wounded Isaiah 58:12

And they that shall be of thee shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and thou shalt be called, The repairer of the breach, The restorer of paths to dwell in.

IV. Safety (23:4)

A. The prospect

Proverbs 14:27

The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.

- 8 We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair;
- 9 Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed;

... and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

Song of Solomon 2:4

He brought me to the banqueting house, and his banner over me was love.

Revelation 19:9

And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

B. The shepherd's portion

Psalm 16:5

The LORD is the portion of mine inheritance and of my cup: thou maintainest my lot.
