



1 Peter 2:4-10

4 To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious, 5 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. **6** Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded. 7 Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner,

1 Peter 2:4-10 - continued

- 8 And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.
- 9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light;
- 10 Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.

Introduction

A. Two key questions were asked in Peter's life
1. The first question
Matthew 16:15-16
15 He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am?

16 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.

2. The last question

John 21:15

So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs.

- B. Consider the first of these questions
 1. What was the impact of this question on Peter's life?
 - 2. What has been the impact of this question on Christianity?
 - 3. How did Peter understand the Lord's response to his answer?

I. Peter Was The Stone (Matthew 16:13-20)

- A. Where was first question? (16:13) Away from religious leaders
- **B.** When was this question asked? (16:13) After being warned of the religious leaders' doctrine
- C. Who was asked this question? (16:13) Those who had responded to Christ's call
- **D.** What was the first answer to the question? (16:14) That which was the common belief
- E. What is the right answer to the question? (16:16) That which is acceptable to God

I. Peter Was The Stone (Matthew 16:13-20)

- F. What was the Lord's response to Peter? (16:18)
- G. What is the confusion concerning this answer? (16:18)
 - 1. Some think Christ was saying Peter was the rock on which He would build His church
 - 2. Peter understood this to mean he was a stone in the church built on Christ the Rock

A. Peter calls all believers "stones"

B. Why stones?

1. Nothing is more dead than a stone

2. This describes all people without Christ Romans 6:23a

For the wages of sin is death; ...

Ephesians 2:1b

...who were dead in trespasses and sins;

C. Believers are stones come to life – "living stones"
1. Declares the power of Christ to give life
Ephesians 2:5

Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

2. The most desperate and sinful can be saved Colossians 2:13-14 13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; 14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Consider The Altar Built At The Jordan River

Deuteronomy 27:6-8

- 5 And there shalt thou build an altar unto the LORD thy God, an altar of stones: thou shalt not lift up any iron tool upon them.
- 6 Thou shalt build the altar of the LORD thy God of whole stones: and thou shalt offer burnt offerings thereon unto the LORD thy God:
- 7 And thou shalt offer peace offerings, and shalt eat there, and rejoice before the LORD thy God.
- 8 And thou shalt write upon the stones all the words of this law very plainly.



D. Living stones demonstrate variety in the church
1. The church is built of God-made stones, no two stones are exactly alike

2. Jesus will use each of us in a special way Romans 12:4-5

4 For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office:

5 So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.

III. Jesus Christ Is The Cornerstone (1 Peter 2:4, 6-8) A. Christ is the only foundation to build our lives on

Matthew 7:24-25

24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:

25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

1 Corinthians 3:11

For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

III. Jesus Christ Is The Cornerstone (1 Peter 2:4, 6-8)**B.** This foundation is strong because it is solid rock **Deuteronomy 32:4** He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he. **Psalms 18:2a** The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust;

III. Jesus Christ Is The Cornerstone (1 Peter 2:4, 6-8)C. All who do not build upon Him build on sand **Matthew 7:26-27** 26 And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: 27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.

III. Jesus Christ Is The Cornerstone (1 Peter 2:4, 6-8) **D.** This Rock has been rejected by men (2:7) **John 1:11-12** 11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not. 12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:
