The Work Of The Holy Spirit In The World

- A. Convicts of sin, righteousness, and judgment John 16:8-11
- 8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 9 Of sin, because they believe not on me;
- 10 Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more;
- 11 Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.

The Work Of The Holy Spirit In The World

- B. Teaches people about Christ and glorifies Him John 16:13-14
- 13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.
- 14 He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

The Work Of The Holy Spirit In The World

C. Brings people to salvation

Acts 2:37

Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?

What Does The Holy Spirit Do At The Moment Of Conversion?

Titus 3:5

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

A. All are spiritually dead because of sin Ephesians 2:1

And you both he quickened who were dead to be a spiritually dead because of sin Ephesians 2:1

And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins;

Colossians 2:13

And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;

- B. Nicodemus and Jesus John 3:5-7
- 5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.
- 7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

C. Regeneration means new birth

Matthew 9:16-17

16 No man putteth a piece of new cloth unto an old garment, for that which is put in to fill it up taketh from the garment, and the rent is made worse.

17 Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.

II. The Holy Spirit Takes Up His Residence In The Believer

1 Corinthians 6:19-20

19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

II. The Holy Spirit Takes Up His Residence In The Believer

A. Jesus promised this to His disciples

John 14:16-17

16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; 17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

II. The Holy Spirit Takes Up His Residence In The Believer

- B. Evidence of the Occupant in the believer's life
 - 1. The Bible becomes a new book

Lamentations 3:23

They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.

- 2. The fruit of the Spirit starts showing up in life Ephesians 5:9-10
- 9 (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;)
- 10 Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord.

II. The Holy Spirit Takes Up His Residence In The Believer

- B. Evidence of the Occupant in the believer's life (continued)
- 3. Power to overcome sin becomes a daily experience Galatians 5:16
- This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.
- 4. A new longing to holy living becomes part of life 1 Peter 1:15
- But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;

Ephesians 4:30
And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

- A. Sealing speaks of ownership
- B. Holy Spirit's presence is like a down-payment Ephesians 1:13-14
- 13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
- 14 Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

- C. The witness of the Spirit guarantees this sealing Romans 8:14-16
- 14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
- 15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.
- 16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

D. Guarantees that what God has begun He will finish Philippians 1:6

Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:

1 Corinthians 12:13

For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

- A. This takes place at conversion
- B. These facts must be noted about the baptism of the Spirit
 - 1. All references to the baptism of the Spirit before Pentecost are prophetic

Joel 2:28-29

- 28 And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions:
- 29 And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.

- B. These facts must be noted about the baptism of the Spirit
 - 1. All references to the baptism of the Spirit before Pentecost are prophetic continued

Luke 3:16

John answered, saying unto them all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:

- B. These facts must be noted about the baptism of the Spirit continued
- 2. After Pentecost all references speak of it as happening in the believer's life at conversion Galatians 3:26-27
- 26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.
- 27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.
 - 3. No Scripture teaches us to seek the baptism of the Spirit

The baptism of the Spirit places the believer into the body of Christ
