John 14:1-6

1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

4 And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.

5 Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Introduction

A. Many people have troubled hearts today

1. Troubled over world events

Luke 21:9-15

9 But when ye shall hear of wars and commotions, be not terrified: for these things must first come to pass; but the end is not by and by.

10 Then said he unto them, Nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom:

11 And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven.

1. Troubled over world events

Luke 21:9-15 - continued

12 But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake.

13 And it shall turn to you for a testimony.

14 Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer:

15 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist.

2. Troubled about moral decline

Matthew 24:12

And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

Matthew 24:37-39

37 But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

38 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark,

39 And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

3. Troubled with other things so that you do not see what is happening

Luke 10:40-41

40 But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to him, and said, Lord, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? bid her therefore that she help me.

41 And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things:

C. The cure for troubled hearts is Jesus

1 Peter 5:7

Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.

A. Why were the disciples troubled?

1. One of them would soon betray Jesus

John 13:21

When Jesus had thus said, he was troubled in spirit, and testified, and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me.

2. They would soon be separated from Jesus

John 13:36

Simon Peter said unto him, Lord, whither goest thou? Jesus answered him, Whither I go, thou canst not follow me now; but thou shalt follow me afterwards.

A. Why were the disciples troubled?

3. Peter would soon deny Jesus

John 13:37-38

37 Peter said unto him, Lord, why cannot I follow thee now? I will lay down my life for thy sake.

38 Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice.

I. Jesus Is The Cure For Unsettled Hearts (14:1)

B. How could Jesus cure their unsettled hearts?

1. One among them would fail, but Christ is always faithful

2 Timothy 2:13

If we believe not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself.

2. One among them would be a liar, but Christ is always true

Revelation 3:14

And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

**B. How could Jesus cure their unsettled hearts? –
continued**

**3. They would soon witness death, but Christ is
always the life**

John 1:4

In him was life; and the life was the light of men.

John 11:25

**Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life:
he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall
he live:**

I. Jesus Is The Cure For Unsettled Hearts (14:1)

C. Keeping their hearts focused on Christ brings peace

John 14:27

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

D. This is true today

Isaiah 26:3

Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

II. Jesus Is The Cure For Uncertain Hearts (14:4)

“We know not whither thou goest”

A. The uncertainty of eternity

B. Christ came to answer that question forever (14:2)

1. A promise of a future home

2. A promise of a furnished home

3. A promise of a fulfilled home

II. Jesus Is The Cure For Uncertain Hearts (14:4)

C. There is no longer any need to be uncertain about eternity

1 John 5:13

These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.

III. Jesus Is The Cure For Unsaved Hearts (14:4-6)

“How can we know the way?”

A. Thomas didn't want to miss out on heaven

John 11:6

Then said Thomas, which is called Didymus, unto his fellowdisciples, Let us also go, that we may die with him.

B. Thomas expected a path and a person – Jesus

III. Jesus Is The Cure For Unsaved Hearts (14:4-6)

“How can we know the way?”

C. Thomas got THE answer from Jesus

D. Thomas still would need to be convinced

John 20:29

Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.
