



1 Peter 1:15-16

15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

Introduction

A. Holiness is commanded by God Leviticus 11:44-45

44 For I am the LORD your God: ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy; for I am holy: neither shall ye defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.
45 For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.

Introduction

B. Holiness is to be worn Numbers 15:39-40 39 And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that ye may look upon it, and remember all the commandments of the LORD, and do them ; and that ye seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which ye use to go a whoring: 40 That ye may remember, and do all my commandments, and be holy unto your God.



Introduction

C. Holiness is blessed by God Psalm 24:4-5

4 He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.5 He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation.

Holiness is conferred by Christ but achieved by our lifestyle

I. Holiness Reflects Being Healed

- **A. Conferred by Christ**
- **1 Peter 2:24**

Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

I. Holiness Reflects Being Healed

B. Continued in Christ 1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

James 5:16

Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

II. Holiness Reflects Being Obedient

1 Peter 1:14 As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance:

II. Holiness Reflects Being Obedient

- **A. Required from the heart**
- **Ephesians 4:22**
- That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;
- **B.** Reflected on the outside
- **Ephesians 4:24**
- And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

III. Holiness Reflects Learning and Living

A. Learning of Christ

Ephesians 3:17-19

17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,
18 May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;
19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

III. Holiness Reflects Learning and Living

- **B.** Living for Christ
- 2 Peter 1:5-10
- **5** And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;
- 6 And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness;
- 7 And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.
- 8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

III. Holiness Reflects Learning and Living

- **B. Living for Christ**
- 2 Peter 1:5-10 continued
- 9 But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.
- 10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:

IV. Holiness Reflects Yielding to Christ

- A. We make the choice
- Romans 6:16

Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

IV. Holiness Reflects Yielding to Christ

B. We reap the results

Romans 6:21-22

21 What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of those things is death. 22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.
