## THRNKSGIVING: THE RRT OF CONTENTMENT

I TIMOTHY 6:3-12

#### 1 Timothy 6:3-12

- 3 If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness;
- 4 He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings,
- 5 Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.
- 6 But godliness with contentment is great gain.

#### 1 Timothy 6:3-12 - continued

- 7 For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out.
- 8 And having food and raiment let us be therewith content.
- 9 But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition.
- 10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

#### 1 Timothy 6:3-12 - continued

- 11 But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness.
- 12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

- B. A thankful heart is the key to contentment
  - 1. Expected by God

Colossians 3:15

And let the peace of God rule in yourhearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.

2. Extinguished by the ungodly

**Romans 1:21** 

Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

### I. Thankful People Rejoice In What They Have

#### **Hebrews 13:5**

Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

### I. Thankful People Rejoice In What They Have

- A. Paul was content because he was continually thankful Philippians 4:11-13
- 11 Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content.
- 12 I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need.
- 13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

### I. Thankful People Rejoice In What They Have

B. Thankful people recognize the temporal nature of all earthly things

Job 1:21-22

- 21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
- 22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly.

- A. The desire to be rich rules many people (v 9) James 1:13-16
- 13 Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man:
- 14 But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.
- 15 Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.
- 16 Do not err, my beloved brethren.

- B. The love of money is the root of all evil (v 10)
  - 1. Bondage to the love of money cost the rich young ruler his soul

Luke 18:23-24

- 23 And when he heard this, he was very sorrowful: for he was very rich.
- 24 And when Jesus saw that he was very sorrowful, he said, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God!

- B. The love of money is the root of all evil (v 10)
  - 2. Breaking free from the love of money brought salvation for Zacchaeus

Luke 19:8-9

- 8 And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord: Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold.
- 9 And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forsomuch as he also is a son of Abraham.

- C. Chasing dreams of money and possessions is costly 1. Wasted effort
- **Proverbs 23:4-5**
- 4 Labour not to be rich: cease from thine own wisdom.
- 5 Wilt thou set thine eyes upon that which is not? for riches certainly make themselves wings; they fly away as an eagle toward heaven.

- C. Chasing dreams of money and possessions is costly 1. Wasted effort - continued
- **Matthew 6:19-20**
- 19 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:
- 20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

- C. Chasing dreams of money and possessions is costly (continued)
  - 2. Wasted eternity

**Luke 9:25** 

For what is a man advantaged, if he gain the whole world, and lose himself, or be cast away?

### III. Thankful People Recognize God Gives Us All We Have

- A. Godliness and contentment go together (v 6)
- 2 Corinthians 9:8

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:

### III. Thankful People Recognize God Gives Us All We Have

- B. Contentment comes from knowing and serving Christ 1 Timothy 1:14-15
- 14 And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.
- 15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

### III. Thankful People Recognize God Gives Us All We Have

C. Everything we have is from our loving Savior's hand James 1:17

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

#### **Psalm 100-3-5**

- 3 Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.
- 4 Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.
- 5 For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.
