## C. Described the death of Jesus

### Isaiah 53:4-5

**4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.**

**5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.**

**Isaiah 11:4**

**But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth: with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked.**

**35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.**

#### **a. To Joseph**

**Matthew 1:20-21**

**20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.**

**21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.**

#### **b. To the shepherds**

**Luke 2:10-11**

**10 And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.**

**11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.**

### **2. The taxing that brought them to Bethlehem**

**Micah 5:2**

**But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.**

### **3. The arrival of the wise men**

**Matthew 2:2, 9-10**

**Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.**

**9 When they had heard the king, they departed; and, lo, the star, which they saw in the east, went before them, till it came and stood over where the young child was.**

**10 When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceeding great joy.**

**Isaiah 32:2**

**And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind,  
and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a  
dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land.**

**1. He is like a hiding place from the wind and a covert from the tempest**

**Psalm 32:7**

**Thou art my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble; thou shalt compass me about with songs of deliverance. Selah**

**2. He is like rivers of water in dry places**

**Psalm 63:1**

**O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;**

**John 6:35**

**And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.**

**3. He is like the shadow of a great rock in a weary land**

**Psalm 91**

**1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.**

**2 I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.**

**3 Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.**

### **III. Jesus Was Wonderful In His Death**

#### **Isaiah 53:10-12**

**10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.**

**11 He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.**

**12 Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.**

## **A. All die because of sin**

**Romans 5:12**

**Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:**

### **III. Jesus Was Wonderful In His Death**

**B. Jesus was sinless and died for sinners**

**Romans 5:8**

**But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.**

**1 Peter 3:18**

**For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:**

# **III. Jesus Was Wonderful In His Death**

**C. All our sins were laid on Him**

**Isaiah 53:6**

**All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.**



## **IV. Jesus Is Wonderful In His Coming Kingdom**

**A. The One who died and rose again will come again**

**Isaiah 9:7**

**Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.**

## **IV. Jesus Is Wonderful In His Coming Kingdom**

**B. When He comes to reign the promise to Mary will be fulfilled**

**Luke 1:32-33**

**32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:**

**33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.**

## **IV. Jesus Is Wonderful In His Coming Kingdom**

**C. When He comes the promise to his disciples will be fulfilled**

**John 14:3**

**And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.**

**Acts 1:11**

**Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.**
