B. The dimensions of Deity (9:6)

1. The names describe the character of God Isaiah 44:6

Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.

2. The names describe the context of God 1 Timothy 1:17 Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God, be honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

C. What does the "Everlasting Father" imply? 1. Christ is eternal

Hebrews 7:3

Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the Son of God; abideth a priest continually.

2. Christ is God

John 20:28

And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God.

A. Why Jesus entered time in Bethlehem

1. Bethlehem was the prophesied birthplace Micah 5:2

But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

2. The everlasting One must enter time at this place and time

B. Why Bethlehem was chosen

A place of sorrows

The place of Rachel's death

Genesis 35:19-20
And Rachel died, and was buried in the way to
Ephrath, which is Bethlehem.
And Jacob set a pillar upon her grave: that is the pillar of Rachel's grave unto this day.

b. Jesus is to be a Man of SorrowsIsaiah 53:3He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and

acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

B. Why Bethlehem was chosen - continued

2. The place of David's birth and anointing 1 Samuel 16:1

And the LORD said unto Samuel, How long wilt thou mourn for Saul, seeing I have rejected him from reigning over Israel? fill thine horn with oil, and go, I will send thee to Jesse the Bethlehemite: for I have provided me a king among his sons.

Luke 2:4

And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:)

B. Why Bethlehem was chosen - continued3. Bethlehem means "house of bread"

a. Jesus is the bread of life

John 6:51

I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world

b. He satisfies hungry souls John 6:35

And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

A. The miracles of the incarnation
1. Our Lord's pre-incarnate position (v 6) "the form of God" (appearance)



A. The miracles of the incarnation

- 1. Our Lord's pre-incarnate position (v 6) "the form of God" (appearance)
- 2. Made Himself of no reputation (empty) (v 7)
- 3. Took upon Himself the form of a servant (put on) (v 7)
- 4. Made in the likeness of men (to become like) (v 7)
- 5. Humbled (stooped) Himself and died on the cross for us (v 8)



B. He became subject to time in all this

1. He was born at a particular time

Luke 2:1-2

1 And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be taxed.

2 (And this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.)

B. He became subject to time in all this - continued

2. He experienced growth over time

Luke 2:51

And he went down with them, and came to Nazareth, and was subject unto them: but his mother kept all these sayings in her heart.

- **B.** He became subject to time in all this continued
 - 3. In birth and death, He was on time
- **Galatians 4:4-6**
- 4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, 5 To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.
- 6 And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.

- C. Now He's alive forevermore Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- **Revelation 1:8**
- I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.
