- 5 O that my ways were directed to keep thy statutes!

- A. It reveals the truth of God's Word
- 2 Timothy 3:16
- All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.
- **B.** It teaches sound doctrine
- **Titus 2:1**
- But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine.

I. The Bible Is the Final Authority in Doctrine

C. It protects against false doctrine

Ephesians 4:14

That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive.

II. The Bible Is the Final Authority in Morality

A. It defines right and wrong

Psalm 33:4

For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in truth.

Romans 7:7

What shall we say then? Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.

B. It commands us to live a holy life

Leviticus 20:7

Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be ye holy: for I am the LORD your God.

1 Peter 1:16

Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

Psalm 19:11

Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward.

II. The Bible Is the Final Authority in Morality

C. It provides standards for personal conduct Matthew 5:48

Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

Psalm 119:133

Order my steps in thy word: and let not any iniquity have dominion over me.

A. It will judge all mankind John 12:48

He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.

B. It reveals the consequences of sin Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Galatians 3:24

Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

Romans 10:17

So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
