Jesus is merciful, Jesus will save.**




**Down in the human heart,

Jesus is merciful, Jesus will save.**






**Rescue the perishing,

Tell the poor wand'rer a Savior has died.**



That will be glory, be glory for me.




Friends will be there I have loved long



**1 Peter 3:1-7**

**All Our Relationships Should Reflect God**

## **Ephesians 5:30-33**

**30 For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones.**

**31 For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh.**

**32 This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church.**

**33 Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband.**

# **I. Submission In Sacrificial Love (3:1-2)**

## **1 Peter 3:1-2**

**1 Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives;**

**2 While they behold your chaste conversation coupled with fear.**

# **I. Submission In Sacrificial Love (3:1-2)**

## **A. As a way of life (3:1)**

**Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so *let* the wives *be* to their own husbands in every thing.**

## **B. As a witness of your life (3:1)**

### **1 Corinthians 7:13-14**

**13 And the woman which hath an husband that believeth not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him.**

**14 For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband: else were your children unclean; but now are they holy.**

**1 Peter 2:12**

**Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation.**

## **II. Seek Spiritual Growth (3:3-4)**

### **1 Peter 3:3-4**

**3 Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel;**

**4 But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.**

**Lift up your eyes on high, and behold who hath created these things, that bringeth out their host by number: he calleth them all by names by the greatness of his might, for that he is strong in power; not one faileth.**

### **B. Contrasted with the world (3:3)**

**1 John 2:15**

**Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.**

### **C. Changed from the inside out by God (3:4)**

#### **1. Soul not self**

**Ephesians 4:24**

**And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.**

#### **2. Sanctified not sinful**

**Ephesians 3:16-17**

**16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;**

**17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,**

## **II. Seek Spiritual Growth (3:3-4)**

**C. Changed from the inside out by God (3:4) - continued**

### **3. Special to God**

**1 Samuel 16:7**

**But the LORD said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for the LORD seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart.**

### **III. Supportive Partnerships (3:5-7)**

#### **A. Tried way (3:5-6)**

**1 Peter 3:5-6**

**5 For after this manner (same way) in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands: 6 Even as Sara obeyed Abraham, calling him lord: whose daughters ye are, as long as ye do well, and are not afraid with any amazement.**

### **III. Supportive Partnerships (3:5-7)**

#### **A. Tried way (3:5-6)**

##### **1. Way for all**

#### **1 Corinthians 12:13**

**For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.**

#### **2 Corinthians 13:11**

**Finally, brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.**
