I. Sense of Vision

A. Evidence of faith

Proverbs 29:18

Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he.

I. Sense of Vision

B. Where to look

1. Looking for God

Hebrews 12:2

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Psalm 121:1

I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help.

I. Sense of Vision

- B. Where to look continued
 - 2. Looking for souls

John 4:35

Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.

3. Looking to help

Philippians 2:4

Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

II. Sense of Hearing

A. Exercise of faith

Romans 10:17

So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

II. Sense of Hearing

- B. We should listen carefully for the voice of God
 - 1. Takes attention

Psalm 46:10

Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.

- 2. Takes attuning
- 1 Kings 19:12

And after the earthquake a fire; but the LORD was not in the fire: and after the fire a still small voice.

II. Sense of Hearing

- B. We should listen carefully for the voice of God
 - 3. Takes acceptance

Matthew 17:5

While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.

III. Sense of Smell

A. Example of faith

Philippians 4:18

But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God.

III. Sense of Smell

- B. A spiritual sense developed by our sacrifice to God Hebrews 13:20-21
- 20 Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,
- 21 Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

IV. Sense of Taste

A. Expectation of faith

Psalm 34:8

O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him.

IV. Sense of Taste

- B. We should become one with Christ
 - 1. By yearning

Psalm 119:103

How sweet are thy words unto my taste! yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth!

- 2. By growing
- 1 Peter 2:1-3
- 1 Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, all evil speakings,
- 2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:
- 3 If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious.

IV. Sense of Taste

- B. We should become one with Christ
 - 3. By abiding

John 17:23

I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.

V. Sense of Touch

A. Exaltation of faith

Matthew 9:21

For she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole.

B. The touch of Christ can make our senses whole Matthew 9:29

Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you.

V. Sense of Touch

C. Our lives should touch others Galatians 6:10

As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.
