I. Where Is The Lake Of Fire Referenced In The Bible?

Revelation 19:20

And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

- I. Where Is The Lake Of Fire Referenced In The Bible?
- A. The beast and false prophet are the first two banished
- B. Their followers slain by Christ and go to Hell (Hades) Revelation 19:21

And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

I. Where Is The Lake Of Fire Referenced In The Bible?

- C. Satan bound into a bottomless pit shortly thereafter Revelation 20:1-3
- 1 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.
 2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,
 3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up,
- and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

I. Where Is The Lake Of Fire Referenced In The Bible?

- D. Satan cast into the lake of fire after the 1000 year reign of Christ and the last battle
- **Revelation 20:7-10**
- 7 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,
- 8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog, and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.
- 9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.
- 10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

A. Hell is the place of punishment in after death of all unbelievers until the Second Death

Luke 16:19-26

- 19 There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day: 20 And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores,
- 21 And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.

- **Luke 16:19-26 continued**
- 22 And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried;
- 23 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.
- 24 And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.

- A. Hell is the place of punishment in after death of all unbelievers until the Second Death
- Luke 16:19-26 continued
- 25 But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented.
- 26 And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence.

B. Hell's characteristics

1. Separation from God

Matthew 7:23

And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

2. Burning flame

Mark 9:45

And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:

B. Hell's characteristics

3. Darkness (Absence of God)

Mark 8:12

But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth

4. Torment (that you wish on nobody)

Luke 16:28

For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment.

- C. No paradise seen after Christ redemptive work* Ephesians 4:8-10
- 8 Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.
- 9 (Now that he ascended, what is it but that he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth?
- 10 He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.)

III. What Is The Second Death That Sends One There?

Revelation 20:11-14

- 11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.
- 12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.
- 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.
- 14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

III. What Is The Second Death That Sends One There?

- A. All wicked resurrected after the last battle
- B. All wicked judged for their works
- C. All wicked condemned because of their unbelief Revelation 20:15
- And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.


Revelation 21:8

But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

III. What Is The Second Death That Sends One There?

D. Demons also cast there Jude 1:6

And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.
