Wherefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints,

1 Thessalonians 1:8

For from you sounded out the word of the Lord not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your faith to God-ward is spread abroad; so that we need not to speak any thing.

I. Encouraged To Pray (1:15-16)

- B. In thanksgiving for others (1:16)
- Ephesians 1:16
- Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers;
- Colossians 3:15
- And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which Also ye are called in one body,; and be ye thankful.
