1 Peter 5:6-10

- 6 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:
- 7 Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.
- 8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- 9 Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.
- 10 But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you.

- A. So much in this world is impersonal
 - 1. Sign of living in a fallen world
- Ecclesiastes 2:22-23
- 22 For what hath man of all his labour, and of the vexation of his heart, wherein he hath laboured under the sun?
 23 For all his days are sorrows, and his travail grief; yea, his heart taketh not rest in the night. This is also vanity.

Psalm 127:2

It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: for so he giveth his beloved sleep.

Casting all your care upon Him

- A. So much in this world is impersonal
 - 2. Sign of the living in the end times
- **Matthew 24:7-8**
- 7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.
- 8 All these are the beginning of sorrows.

Casting all your care upon Him

B. But God still knows you are an individual John 10:3

To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out.

Casting all your care upon Him

C. Jesus is a personal God

Hebrews 4:15

For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

- 1. Zacchaeus and his hiding in the tree
- 2. The woman who touched the hem of his garment
- 3. The children: He laid His hands on them and prayed
- 4. Even those who were demon-possessed

- B. Cares are roadblocks to blessings
- **Matthew 13:22**
- He also that received seed among the thorns is he that heareth the word; and the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word, and he becometh unfruitful.

Psalm 34:19

Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.

John 14:27

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

D. The joy of the Lord is your strength (Nehemiah 8:10) Nehemiah 8:10

Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our LORD: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

B. He waits to take all your cares

Matthew 11:28
